



## **NAVAL RESERVE OFFICER TRAINING CORPS SCHOLARSHIP**

The Naval Reserve Officers Training Program (NROTC) Marine Option is an \$180,000+ scholarship program that covers 4 years of higher education. In addition to a normal academic workload leading to a Baccalaureate degree, NROTC scholarship students attend various military classes for drill, physical training, and other activities all while getting paid to go to school. During the summer break between school years, NROTC students participate in paid training activities. Upon completion of the scholarship, applicants would be commissioned as a Marine Officer in the United States Marine Corps.

### **BENEFITS**

Full tuition at any of the participating schools to cover the following:

- All mandatory fees imposed by the School on all full-time undergraduate students.
- Stipend for text books
  - Currently \$750 per academic year (\$375 per semester or \$250 per quarter)
- Uniforms and Naval Science textbooks
- Three summer cruises
- Subsistence (food) allowance each academic month:
  - Freshmen - \$250/month
  - Sophomore - \$300/month
  - Junior - \$350/month
  - Senior - \$400/month

Requirements:

In addition to meeting specific medical, mental, and moral requirements, an applicant would have to achieve one of the qualifying scores on the SAT (minimum of 1000 combined), the ACT (minimum of 22), or the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery Test (74 minimum). Additionally, applicants would have to be accepted into an institution that is participating in the program.
